- > Exam options in January and June
- > Internationally focused course content

- AS level can be used to complete an IAL or taken in conjunction with IALs as a stand-alone qualification.

Both Edexcel GCE A levels and International Advanced Levels prepare students with the skills and knowledge required to gain access to worldclass universities. They can be studied together; in conjunction with national qualifications; or with vocational qualifications such as BTEC or LCCI, to provide a comprehensive suite of subjects to study.

*Proposed reforms by the UK government from September 2015 onwards will see GCE A levels move from a modular assessment structure, to linear in some subjects.
