# **Register and book**

Before booking you will need to create a Pearson account and read the test taker handbook.

- 1. Visit pearsonpte.com/book

# What to expect on test day

**PTE Academic** is taken at a secure test center, where candidates will need to check-in with the test administrator, show ID and sit their test in a secure computer room.



On check-in the test administrator will provide the candidate with a copy of the test center rules to read, request copies of ID, ask for a digital photograph and signature, and scan the test taker's palm.

The candidate will be assigned a locker to check-in their belongings before sitting the test in the secure room.

The test administrator monitors candidates throughout the test.
